PROTOCOL

ACADEMICS

The term came to an end successfully with all academic programmes executed to time. The result of which is already available on line and hard copy given to the students.

Senior Secondary Certificate Examinations, WAEC & NECO were successfully conducted and the results for WAEC already available on Net. The result of the Basic Education Certificate Examination for JSS3 conducted earlier in the year has been released and the interim analysis conducted showed good performance on the side of the students.

STUDENTS' WELFARE

The College authority worked hard to satisfy the students within the limit of resources available to the College. However it must be registered that the welfare in the hostel is an aggregate of home provisions and therefore cannot meet entirely the standard of every home. To this effect, parents are enjoined to admonish their ward to understand that hostel conditions is part of their training. We may in the future also look at the option of subsidy of welfare from parents through the instrumentality of the Parent-Teacher Association.

CONDUCTS OF STUDENTS

The trend in bad behavior of some students is alarming, what one observes in the world of the adults have crept into teenage level of conduct. Parents are advised to step up the monitoring of their children and regularly admonish them to protect the name of their family. It is also necessary to note the response of students to academics, particularly when they get to SS3. Parents should note that emphasis on certificate at all cost, leading to all forms of examination malpractices are not in the best interests of the students. Knowledge is power, Certificate is ordinary evidence!

PECULIAR HEALTH ISSUES

Parents of students with serious health issues are reminded of the limitations of the College on management of health related matters. Parents should please note that the College has no medical facilities to cope with some serious ailments as Sickle Cell, Aneamic heart condition, Asthma etc. You may also need to declare with medical evidence, ailments that may need special attention. We advise that such children should be kept as day students.

NAMES ON UNIFORM

The directive of the College that boys should properly identify all personal items was not met with desired compliance and this did not help in resolving attendant issue of stealing. We enjoin parents to obey this directive to further minimize issue of stealing in the hostel and careless abandon of personal items.
