The best Lagos TAFMUN Conference delegate will win a Lufthansa German Airlines ticket to Model-UN conference at the UN Headquarters, New York USA in March 2019.

We also solicit the support of every parent in ensuring that school fees and PTA tellers are presented on or before the resumption date for the 1<sup>st</sup> term 2018/2019 session.
