MY DEAR KINGS' COLLEGE PARENTS,

We thank the Almighty God for seeing us through another term. I appreciate all parents/guardians for their support and cooperation during this 2nd term 2017/2018 session.

PTA GENERAL MEETING

The PTA Annual General Meeting for this term was held on Saturday 17th March 2018. The meeting was well attended and some crucial issues were discussed and agreed upon. The account for the year was distributed and parents requested for time to study it and a motion for the adoption of the account for discussion during the next PTA meeting was moved and adopted.

HIGHLIGHTS AND RESOLUTIONS OF THE MEETING:

1. The new PKC Mr. Kolawole Isaac was introduced and welcomed by all.
2. Issues on stealing and no fan facilities in J.S.S. 1 classrooms were discussed with the school management promising to look into the matter of insufficient fans in the classrooms. There was an anonymous donation of some fans. The PKC promised to look into the incidence of stealing. Parents/guardians were informed that someone has been employed to pick up missing/abandoned clothing items and wash them. The PKC advised parents to always mark the names of their sons on all clothing items for easy identification. He also stated that all lost but found items would attract a token fee upon collection by the owners.
3. The PKC dwelt on the issue of academic performance of our children and promised henceforth, that teaching activities in the classroom would be properly monitored to improve upon the current academic standard.
4. The account for the year was distributed and parents requested for time to study it and a motion for the adoption of the account for

discussion during the next PTA meeting was moved and adopted.

5. After much deliberations on how to fund the hostel project (with the approval of the Federal Ministry of Education to discuss the funding as announced by the PKC) and based on the estimate provided by the quantity surveyor, the house agreed to levy each student a sum of ₦30,000. This can be paid at once or spread over a period of 3 terms (i.e. ₦10,000 per term) starting from next term. The Chairman announced that a 20- man committee would be inaugurated with chairman as the chairperson of the committee to oversee the building project. A form will be sent via email to all interested persons before the end of the week.

I'm personally appealing to my dear parents/guardians who have high link in some reputable places (Government, Church, Banks, Telecommunications, Individual and so on) to help us in completing this building so that the burden can be lifted off all parents.

OTHER INFORMATION

In order to serve our Kings better, and because of high cost of items in the market, the midday meal fees has been slightly increased to ₦9,000. While the laundry ₦4,500 for more effectiveness.
