**THE TONE OF DISCIPLINE IN  
THE COLLEGE**

**SEA SCHOOL LEADERSHIP  
TRAINING**

The Sea School, Apapa will organize leadership Training for Secondary School Students this summer. While it is optional for other students it is compulsory for our prefects. The cost of registration, accommodation and feeding is Thirty-Eight Thousand Naira (N38,000.00) only. The College Management and PTA will pay Thirteen Thousand Naira (N13,000.00) each while the students/Parents will pay Twelve Thousand Naira (N12,000.00) only.

## **EXTERNAL EXAMINATION**

The basic Education Certificate Examination (BECE) result has been released. Our students' performance in the examination is above average. The result of the just concluded WAEC, SSCE has also been released. Candidates can now check their results on line. Based on the few results parents have shared with us so far, we are hopeful that our result this year will be very good.

Please note that no student is **ALLOWED** to write External Examination(s). All SS3 students **MUST** resume within the first week of resumption otherwise, they will be considered to have voluntarily withdrawn from the College.

## **DAY STUDENTSHIP**

Parents are advised to acquaint themselves with the guidelines on Day Studentship – a copy is at the PTA office. Day students must always come to school with the approved College Uniforms. With effect from next term, the College Gate will be **shut at 8.00am** prompt. Please ensure that your child/ward is in the school on time.

All day students must present their payment receipts on the Monday of resumption before they will be allowed to enter the compound.

## **SICK BAY**

Parent should always disclose health issues/status of their children/wards to the Management for effective care. You should advise them to report all cases of ill-health to the sick-bay staff promptly. Personal drugs should be deposited at the sick-bay for proper monitoring. Students are not allowed to administer drugs on themselves without the active supervision of the Sick-Bay personnel.

## **CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

In a bid to give an all-round education to our students they are encourage to actively participate in different sporting activities and clubs/societies. Master Ademola Adegoke of SS1 won the grand prize Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand Naira (N250,000.00) of Eco-Friendly Children's Painting Contest organized by EKO Hotel and Suites during the session.

Abdrahman Oluwatofunmi Sheriff, an SS2 student of the College, conquered Africa by becoming the best Africa Speller on November 24, 2018. He won a Gold Medal for Nigeria, \$20,000 cash and a scholarship to study in one of the best universities in Africa, Monash University of South Africa. He was invited to represent Africa at the International Team Olympiad Tournament in Princeton, New Jersey, USA. Unfortunately, he could not attend the International Meet due to visa issues.

Our students also participated in the preliminaries of the 2019 edition of the Federal Unity Colleges National Debate held at the Federal Government College, Odogbolu in June 2019. King's College qualified to represent the Southwest Zone at the finals in Abuja on a date yet to be announced.

The College Team participated in the 8<sup>th</sup> edition of the GTB Masters Cup youth league and won the Gold Medal by winning the Cup.

### **SCHOOL FEES/PTA LEVIES**

Payment of approved school fees/PTA levies is MANDATORY FOR ALL students. Therefore, no student (Boarders and Day) will be allowed into the compound without full payment of their fees.

### **STUDENTS WELFARE**

The school with the co-operation of the PTA fumigated all the Hostels in order to tackle the issue of Bed-Bug. Debugging the hostels is an ongoing project. Parents are urged to debug their sons' bags and mattresses before returning to school.

### **PECULIAR HEALTH ISSUES**

Parents should ensure that their children are in good health condition before bringing them back to the School. No sick students will be checked in.

### **HOSTEL MATERIALS**

The following are the usual items for the boarding house and they will be checked at the point of receiving the boys. Any student

with incomplete items will not be checked in.

- ❖ two stainless steel plates to be submitted at the point of checking in
- ❖ At least two sets of Cutleries
- ❖ Mosquito net
- ❖ Five complete set of uniforms
- ❖ Complete set of House uniform
- ❖ 2 white bed sheets
- ❖ Coverlet
- ❖ Pillow and cover
- ❖ Bucket
- ❖ Drinking Cup
- ❖ Maintenance and House Due (N2,500.00)
- ❖ Cover cloth
- ❖ Boys must keep their hair low and well-timed finger nail.

### **PROHIBITED ITEMS**

The following items are still prohibited in the College

- ❖ Phones
- ❖ Pressing Iron
- ❖ Tin/Can food
- ❖ Sardines/other liquid processed food
- ❖ Glass bottles

- ❖ Body sprays or perfumes, except roll on in plastic containers
- ❖ Coloured under-wears
- ❖ Black under-wears

Please note that these items will be confiscated, if found with any student

### **NAMES ON UNIFORM**

Our boys are in the habits of carelessly abandoning their uniforms and more often picking other student's uniforms, depriving victims of what to wear for the day. In order to stem this ugly situation, it is now mandatory for every student to sew or inscribe his name on the pockets of his uniforms. Other personal items can equally be properly identified.
